

ORDERLY ACCUSED AS HIT-AND-RUN DRIVER

Ray Cornelius, an orderly at the Soldiers' Home, was charged with manslaughter and with failure to stop and give aid after an automobile accident in a complaint that was issued yesterday by Dep. Dist.-Atty. Davis. The complaint avers Cornelius was involved in an automobile accident near Clover Field the 6th Inst. in which Mrs. Estella May Davison of 3415 Sabina street was killed and her husband, Elmer Davison, injured. It charges further that Cornelius failed to stop. His companion in the car, Alex Bouricand, also a hospital orderly, was not accused.
