

CASUALTIES.

A Farmer's Fatal Mishap—A Man and Two Children Cremated Alive.

CARTHAGE, Mo., November 14.—On Saturday evening Jesse Thacker of this city was kicked by one of his horses and died at noon to-day from the effects thereof. The deceased was born in Ohio, and at intervals lived in Kentucky and Illinois. He came to Carthage with his family twenty years ago last Saturday. He owned in this county nearly 6,000 acres of farms, and also in several additions to the city of Carthage. He also owned a hardware store here, and possessed large property in Illinois. He was married to his third wife, a Mrs. Margaret Cooper of Chapman, Morgan County, Ill., three and a half years ago. They lived together only a few months, and she commenced suit for a divorce. The final legal outcome is yet resting with the Supreme Court. Deceased leaves five children to inherit his wealth.
